- Conference Schedule has been completed in rough draft format.
- Revised Conference Coordinator contract has been accepted by NCSU Office of Professional Development.
- Gertha Heggie will be our point of contact. Chip Futrell is also assisting with logistical issues.
- Contract vote on January 8, 2009 showed the vast majority approve of Concord as the 2009 site. The majority vote for 2010 is to not select a site at this time. All email votes presented will be given to the Chalres McDowell for certification.
- State budget is continuing to deteriorate. This week the governor signed an executive order outlying areas where \$2 billion dollars can be cut immediately from the current FY budget. That is approx. 10% of total budget. It isn't certain now where cuts will come from.
- Proposed contract does have a force majeure clause. The Embassy Suites has accepted the modification to the clause. However, to get this we will not get the requested 30 day cancellation clause for food.
